



Town of Victoria: 2026 Administrator's Decisions

08-Apr-26	067-2026	<p>Community-Driven Advisory Committee: The FireSmart Advisory Committee is intended to be a community-driven advisory body, bringing together public members, Council, and Town representatives to provide local knowledge and community-based perspectives on wildfire risk reduction and preparedness initiatives.</p> <p>This approved funding also complements the Town of Victoria's 2026 Budget commitments to support recreation initiatives and further reduce wildfire risk within the community.</p> <p>The FireSmart Advisory Committee shall review the Terms of Reference at its first meeting, and any recommended amendments or clarifications shall be forwarded to Council for consideration and approval.</p> <p>Final appointments to the FireSmart Advisory Committee shall be made by resolution of Council, following the completion of the application and review process.</p>	<p>Directive: As the Town of Victoria has been successful in securing funding totaling \$30,000 from the Department of Forestry, Agriculture and Lands to support wildfire risk reduction and community preparedness initiatives. The town will now take steps to establish a community-driven Fire Smart Advisory Committee to provide advice and recommendations related to these initiatives.</p> <p>This directive approves the Town of Victoria FireSmart Advisory Committee's Terms of Reference.
