


09-Apr-26	70.2026	<p><b>By-Law:</b> The Town is required under the <b>Towns and Local Service Districts Act</b> to adopt a <b>mandatory Arrears By-Law</b> governing the collection of outstanding taxes, fees, and charges. The draft mandatory Arrears By-Law has been reviewed by the Town's legal representative to ensure compliance with legislative requirements and to confirm that it provides a clear and enforceable framework for the management of municipal arrears.</p> <p>In keeping with principles of public engagement, the draft By-Law is being released for a fourteen (14) day public comment period. Public input is welcomed and appreciated, and any comments received will be considered prior to final adoption of the By-Law.</p> <p>Written comments may be submitted by email, mail, or in person as follows:</p> <p><b>By Mail or In Person:</b> Town of Victoria P.O. Box 130 271 Main Highway Victoria, NL A0A 4G0</p> <p><b>By Email:</b> townofvictoria@nf.aibn.com</p>	<p><b>Direction:</b> Directs that the draft <b>mandatory</b> Town of Victoria <b>Arrears By-Law</b>, having been reviewed by the Town's legal representative and determined to be legally sound, be released for public review and comment.</p> <p>The draft By-Law shall be made available for public input for a period of fourteen (14) days.</p> <p>The Town Clerk Manager is authorized and directed to publish notice of the public review period, make the draft By-Law publicly accessible, and receive comments in accordance with the <b>Towns and Local Service Districts Act</b>.</p> <p><b>All comments must be submitted to the Town Office by April 24, 2026, and may be provided by email, mail, or in person.</b></p>
